Please see attached comments and Habitat Regulations Assessment for Likely Significant Effects for the above application. The ecologist has stated that they will be undertaking further surveys for horseshoe bats as the full surveys have not been undertaken.

A Habitat Regulations Assessment for Likely Significant Effects has been undertaken and the preliminary screening has identified that it is not obvious that the proposal could not have any conceivable effect on a European Site during construction and operation and therefore without protective measures there is conceivably likely significant effect.

Once we have received the further information above the application will be taken to Appropriate Assessment. You do not need to re-consult Natural England until an Appropriate Assessment is undertaken.
