In accordance with regulation 18 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, Forest of Dean District Council have produced this Decision Statement in relation to the Berry Hill, Christchurch and Edge End Neighbourhood Development Plan submitted to them by West Dean Parish Council.

Following an independent examination of written representations, the Examiners Report was considered by Full Council on the 19th October 2017. Having considered each of the recommendations made by the Examiner, and the reasons for them, the District Council has decided to make the modifications proposed by the examiner to the draft Plan to ensure that it meets the Basic Conditions set out in the legislation. These are set out in the list of changes.

Forest of Dean District Council now confirms that the Berry Hill, Christchurch and Edge End Neighbourhood Development Plan will proceed to a neighbourhood planning referendum.
