**COMPULSORY PURCHASE OF LAND AT HUGHES TERRACE, LYDNEY**

Notice is hereby given that Forest of Dean District Council have made the Forest of Dean District Council (Land at Hughes Terrace, Lydney) Compulsory Purchase Order 2018 under section 226(1)(a) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. It is about to submit this order to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government for confirmation and if confirmed, the order will authorise Forest of Dean District Council to purchase compulsorily the land described below for the purposes of carrying out redevelopment of abandoned derelict premises for re-use as a community facility thereby achieving the promotion and/or improvement of the economic, social or environmental well-being of the area.

A copy of the order and of the accompanying map may be seen at all reasonable hours at the Council Offices, High Street, Gloucestershire GL16 8HG.

Any objection to the order must be made in writing to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, National Planning Casework Unit, 5 St Philip's Place, Colmore Row, Birmingham B3 2PW or [npcu@communities.gsi.gov.uk](mailto:npcu@communities.gsi.gov.uk) before 1st February 2019 and should state the title of the order, the grounds of objection and the objector's address and interests in the land.

In submitting an objection it should be noted that your personal data and correspondence will be passed to the Council to enable your objection to be considered. If you do not wish your personal data to be forwarded, please state your reasons when submitting your objection and the Secretary of State will copy your representations, with your name and address removed to the Council and if there is to be a Public Inquiry they will be seen by the Inspector who may give them less weight as a result.

**DESCRIPTION OF LAND**

All that land at Hughes Terrace, Lydney comprising of the property formerly known as "Shewards Shop" and the accompanying residential property annexed thereto together with all outbuildings and yard accompanying the former shop and residential property.
