COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2018

The Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended)
and the Acquisition of Land Act 1981

The FOREST OF DEAN DISTRICT COUNCIL (in this order called "the Acquiring Authority") makes the following order:-

1. Subject to the provisions of this Order, the Acquiring Authority is under section 226 (1)(a) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 hereby authorised to purchase compulsorily the land described in paragraph 2 for the purposes of carrying out redevelopment of abandoned derelict premises for re-use as a community facility thereby achieving the promotion and/or improvement of the economic, social or environmental well-being of the area.
2. The land authorised to be purchased compulsorily under this order is the land described in the Schedule and delineated in red on a map prepared in duplicate, sealed with the Common Seal of the Acquiring Authority and marked "Map referred to in the Forest of Dean District Council (Land at Hughes Terrace, Lydney) Compulsory Purchase Order 2018."

SCHEDULE

All that land at Hughes Terrace, Lydney comprising of the property formerly known as "Shewards Shop" and the accompanying residential property annexed thereto together with all outbuildings and yard accompanying the former shop and residential property.
