

COMMUNITY SAFETY PARTNERSHIP GRANT 2019-20

The Community Safety Partnership has a budget of £18,853 from the Police Crime Commissioner (PCC) to be spent on community safety projects within the Forest of Dean which are aligned with the PCC 6 priority areas (Accessibility and Accountability, Older but not overlooked, Young people becoming adults, Safe days and nights for all, Safe and social driving and Safer Cyber). Other priorities to be considered are local policing parish, Domestic Abuse, Hate Crime and Safer Gloucestershire.

There is no limit to how much each group can apply for (up to the total of funding available) but non-constituted groups will only be able to apply for a maximum of £500. Each award must have matched funding which can be financial or in kind. This grant will be made available until March 2020 or until all funds are allocated – they will be allocated on a first come basis.
