**(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2012**  
**Variation Order No. 1 of 2025**

Notice is hereby given that on 04/11/2025 Forest of Dean District Council made the above Order under section 32, 35, 35C and Schedule 9 (Part IV) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 and all other enabling powers and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police.

**TITLE**

Forest of Dean District Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2012 (Variation No. 1) Order 2025

The effect of the Order will be to further vary the Forest of Dean District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2012 as follows:-

1. Incorporate Pyarts **Court Car Park, Coleford** into the parking order.
2. Incorporate the **residents parking bays at the Council car park, Coleford** into the parking order.
3. Incorporate Electric **Vehicle Charging bays** in existing Parking Places into the parking order.
4. Incorporate Electric Vehicle Charging bays in:
  - **Rowandean car park, Cinderford**
  - **Butlers Mead car park, Blakeney**
  - **Grange Lane car park Littledean**into the parking order.
5. Bring the parking order up to date in respect of current management and enforcement provisions and practices.

The order will otherwise remain in in full force and effect.

This variation order will come into effect **1<sup>st</sup> December 2025**

If any person wishes to question the validity of the order or that of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
