In order to be able to continue to preserve and maintain our local services the precept requirement for West Dean Parish Council for the year 2023/24 is £216,211 which is based upon the estimate of expenditure as set out below.

Unlike the larger District and County Councils the Parish Council receives no funding from Central Government or Business Rates, so the net costs of our services are funded entirely from the council taxpayers of West Dean.

The small element of your overall council tax bill which comes our way is based on a Band D property and equates to £62.39 per annum which is £1.20 per week for 2023/24.

The parish council promotes the interests of West Dean in its representations to other bodies and works in partnership with the District Council, and other agencies to provide and supplement local government services within West Dean. The Parish Council is consulted on all planning applications made in respect of properties in West Dean and written representations are submitted to the FODDC planning department.

Meetings of the Parish Council are open to the press and public and all meetings are publicised on the Parish Council's website – www.westdeanpc.org.uk. There is an opportunity for members of the public to raise any concerns or queries that they have with the Parish Council.
