

Zoo Licensing Act 1981

Application form for renewal of an existing licence

Section 6(1) of the Zoo Licensing Act 1981 requires that an application for renewal of a zoo licence must be sent to the local authority not later than 6 months before the due expiry date of the licence. Since a re-inspection of the zoo is also required by that date (except where a direction has been issued by the Secretary of State under Section 15 of the Act) the application should preferably be made at least 8 months before the expiry date in order to allow sufficient time for re-inspection to be arranged and carried out.
